Norec also coordinates recruitment of Norwegian citizens to positions funded by the Norwegian government at the UN and the World Bank. This includes positions as Junior Professional Officers and United Nations Volunteers.



Norec Grants to Partnerships with Zambia (USD 2022) \$413,23K


